

Abundance Malvern report for the 2022 AGM

2021 was a successful year for Abundance Malvern in spite of the Covid pandemic.

Picking: We picked on a total of 4 days, in 6 gardens plus the Three Counties Orchard, with around 14 volunteers.

Distributing: We distributed apples, as we picked, to the volunteers and through Freegle to individuals. Neighbours and friends also had large quantities. Malvern Green Space collected several trays of apples and pears for distribution at their Harvest Abundance Fruit & Veg Swap at Malvern Link United Reformed Church.

Juicing: In two batches we juiced 312 bottles (26 boxes) at Clive's fruit farm. This amount was based on pre-orders from volunteers, members and those who have had it in previous years.

Volunteers and owners: The website generated some new interest from garden owners and potential volunteers.

Equipment: All the equipment (crates, picking bags, fruit pickers etc.) were well used and made the task much easier.
